## **Heartland Christian Preschool**

Students enrolled in our 3 year-old preschool must be 3 years of age by August 30 of the current school year. Students in our 4 year-old preschool must be 4 years of age by August 30 of the current school year. Children need to be potty trained, be able to sit for at least 5 minutes, and be able to talk. Student application forms are available in the school office. A registration fee is due at the time of enrollment. Children need to be current with their immunizations and provide a copy of their birth certificate and health assessment records.

### **Academics, Social, and Free Time Include:**

- **Bible Time**

Math manipulatives and rote counting. Writing numbers on the white board, with paints, play dough, sand, flour, and shaving cream.
